Our move to the cafeteria this year has made it possible for the children to have more choices in their after-school experience.

Following check-in...**A-C-E...**

We begin with a 45 minute block: Starting with the option for snack and a variety of table activities. There is a group that can choose active play in the gym and also a time for those who want to start on homework.

COMMUNITY BUILDING MEETING

This a brief opportunity for kids to voice concerns & problem solve solutions and offer compliments to peers. We have a fun activity, hear the project and gym options for the afternoon and finish with a "Who Was Listening?" game where 3 contestants are chosen to answer a question about something shared in the meeting. Pickup and Drop Off

Children are permitted to use their electronic devices for homework only and with permission from a teacher. This time will take place from dismissal until 4:15. Any additional homework time needed may be available after 5:15pm.

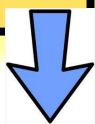
October Theme will take us to Space Exploring the Universe and beyond.
