Act 80 Day Information

for staff

What is an Act 80 day?

Act 80 days are days when MTLSD calls a 12pm dismissal for students in 1st-5th grade. We offer care to families who are scheduled for that day only. MLEDP will be open for typical mornings session as well as care that begins at 12pm when the children are dismissed. We will close at our typical 6:30pm.

How do parents sign up for an Act 80 day?

Parents must sign up for the Act 80 day to get care from 12:00pm-3:30pm.
Care is not guaranteed and is subject to adequate staffing Children who are regularly contracted for afternoons on this day are expected to attend.
Center Directors will confirm expected attendance with families. Parents are not billed separately for these days.

What will my schedule look like on an Act 80 Day?

We rely on afternoon staff to be available for an 11:45am start time on Act 80 days. If schedule conflicts arise staff coverage will be arranged by Kelly.

What will children need for a long day?

Children will need to bring a packed lunch with a drink and weather appropriate clothing including tennis shoes. If any additional items are permitted the Center Director should be sure parents are aware.

How do Act 80 Days effect Kindergarten?

Kindergarten typically has a normal schedule during Act 80 Days. This means that staff that are involved with the bus run are still expected to work with the kindergarten program. Kelly will make a plan if there are challenges in bus staffing.
