Activity Introduction/ Sell It:	We will trace our upper body/head and draw the things we like inside.
Activity Directions:	<p>1) Children will take turns laying down on a piece of paper while a teacher partner traces their head/shoulders.</p> <p>2) Children will fill in the blank space with drawings of their interests, favorite things.</p>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. First the children will mix their own bubble solution in a small cup. 2. They will each get food coloring of their choice dropped into the bubble cup. 3. The children will use the straw to blow bubbles in their cup. 4. Once bubbles are formed, the children will lay the fresh paper on the

top of their bubbles creating a print on the paper. They can move from one cup to another in order to get rainbow colors on each sheet.	
Wrap up- Discuss activity highlights, benefits, successes, take aways	Kids will get to express themselves creatively, share their interests with others.
