Activity Introduction/ Sell It: We are going to play a game called silent library. In a group you have to complete an activity before the time runs out but you have to be quiet or else the librarian can tag you out.		
Activity Directions:	Step-by-step description including rules and procedures. Continued back of form.	
Pick a student to be the librarian. This person will be blindfolded.		
2. Divide the group into 2 or 4 groups depending on the size.		
3.In the middle of the court place a buzzer. This is where the students will pick one person to run and hit the buzzer to indicate that their group finished the round.

Activity Directions Continued:		
4. Each group will get a card telling them what to do before the timer runs out. (I.e. each team member make a basket with the kickball, pass a ball using only noodles, and play a small game of dodgeball between the group until one winner.)		
5. If the librarian hears a noise, they can try to tag the person who is making the noise. If you are tagged you are out. If a whole group gets tagged they are out.		
6. Once a group finishes their task they can ring the buzzer.		
7. Person who rang the buzzer switches with the librarian and becomes the next librarian.		
Wrap up- Discuss activity highlights, benefits, successes, takeaways: Have them come up with their own ideas for tasks and challenges.		
Activity Duration: 25-40		
What Pitfalls might you expect? Librarian doesn't want to be blindfolded, tasks are too hard to do quietly, poor communication in the teams How would you remedy them? Prepare them for this situation and help them expect to be blindfolded if they play, provide modifications for tasks, encourage laughing at goofiness and teamwork
